

CONTEST:

THE FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLES OF THE MAGNA CHARTA UNIVERSITATUM

Prize: up to one year free accommodation at the Collegio Superiore

Art. 1 - Award

The Magna Charta Observatory and the University of Bologna, in the occasion of the 25th Anniversary of the signature of the Magna Charta Universitatum, promote the graphic-photographic and audiovisual prize-winning competition dedicated to the Fundamental Principles of the Magna Charta Universitatum.

Art. 2 – Involvement

The competition is open to incoming international exchange and enrolling students, including doctoral candidates, at the University of Bologna for the academic year 2013-2014

Art. 3 – Object

The applicant will send a visual creation (called from now on "creation") with his/her interpretation of the fundamental principles contained in the Magna Charta Universitatum. The creations accepted will be: *photos*, *paintings*, *drawings*, *graphics*, *audiovisuals*.

In case of audiovisual creations, the maximum duration must be of 3 minutes. Three resolutions are allowed: 1.280x720 pixel resolution 1.920x1.080 pixel resolution

Pictures and other materials: 300 dpi resolution Image: min 8 megapixel File: max 16 megabyte Only one creation can be submitted per person.

Art. 4 – Delivery of the Creation

The creation, together with the entry form duly filled, will have to be submitted as jpg. or mov. file through Wetransfer* - www.wetransfer.com, to the e-mail address: magnacharta@unibo.it. * Wetransfer is an on-line transferring platform that allows to send, free of charge, large files up to 2GB. To transfer files it is necessary to write your e-mail, the e-mail of the addressee and add the files.

Art. 5 – Entry Form and Release

The attached Entry Form includes the Release for Use of Copyright Protected Works and must be sent duly filled together with the creation. You can download the Entry Form from the link: http://www.magna-charta.org/Contest_Entry_Form.aspx

The application is valid only if **both** the creation and the entry form are simultaneously presented.

Art. 6 - Copyright

The creation presented may be used for non-profit promotional purposes by the Magna Charta Observatory and/or by the University of Bologna. Every time the works will be used the name of the author will be displayed. Applicants are kindly invited to carefully read the additional details on the copyright, listed on the annex "Release for Use of Copyright Protected Works"

Art. 7 - Jury

The Jury's decision is final and unappealable. The participation to the contest implies the acceptance of the present rules.

Art. 8 – Registration fee

Art. 9 – Deadline

The entry deadline is September, 8th 2013.

Art. 10 - Prize

The winner will be accommodated at the *COLLEGIO SUPERIORE* – (www.collegio.unibo.it) for the period of his/her stay in Bologna (min. 3 months – max. 12 months).
