A selection of the best abstracts will also be published in the September issue of the Journal of Psychosomatic Research. Because they need to be peer-reviewed, abstracts for consideration of publication in the Journal of Psychosomatic Research must be submitted by April 27th.

Abstracts submitted after April 27th or not accepted for publication on the Journal of Psychosomatic Research will be considered for display at the Congress.

Registration is required for at least one of the authors for publication of the abstract both in the Journal of Psychosomatic Research and in the abstracts book.

Last deadline for abstracts submission is May 31st


