General outline of the event

The workshop is aimed at fixing guidelines for designing, implementing and testing the new teaching modules interfacing science and the humanities that every sub-project of Acume 2 is expected to produce within the next two years. The working sessions will include:

- 1. An outline of several, relevant examples of integrated teaching tools already developed by European and American universities.
- 2. A number of 'good practice' reports in the field of integrated teaching tools by representatives of some European universities.
- 3. The presentation of three teaching modules (on 'Ageing', 'Evolution' and 'Electrifying Culture') being developed by scholars working in the Acume 2 project.
- 4. An open discussion on: assessment of all the teaching materials collected; involvement into the Acume 2 project of other scholars with an experience or an interest in integrated programmes; guidelines for designing, implementing and testing the new teaching modules.
